## Warren Wilford Wildman

Past Grand Patron of the Grand Chapter of California,  
Order of the Eastern Star 1984

Brother Warren was initiated into Elmhurst Chapter No. 455 on January 16, 1963. Through consolidations the chapter became Lake Chabot Chapter No. 103 in Castro Valley in 2008. He was also a plural member of Alameda Oak Leaf Chapter No. 8. He served his Chapter as Associate Patron in 1970 and Worthy Patron in 1971. He became a Life Sponsor of the Home in 1978.

Our Brother had the honor to serve the Grand Lodge as Grand Tiler in 1982. He was active in the Scottish Rite bodies, the Shrine, and the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls. On December 10, 1984 he received the 33<sup>o</sup> from the Scottish Rite.

Warren was elected Associate Grand Patron in 1983 and then Worthy Grand Patron in 1984. He served our Grand Chapter as a member of the following committees: Liaison to Grand Lodge 1974, 1978, 1985-86, 1990; Mileage 1977; Rob Morris Award 1981; Fraternal Relationships 1982; Special Committee to revise the C & L 1985; Eastern Star Home 1989, 1991; Distribution 1993; and Wills, Bequests and Charitable Requests 1997.

Brother Warren's Worthy Patrons were called Sons of Light. His emblem was an All Seeing Eye, a windmill and lantern encompassed in a circle.

Brother Warren entered into the joy of Celestial Life on January 19, 2010. He had been a member of the Order for over 47 years. In his Acceptance speech at his Installation he said:

*“I would ask that we also go back into the grass roots approach,  
and “Reach out and touch someone’s life,”  
Let us love one another.””*
